The data is also used to determine the location of schools, hospitals, and other community facilities.

LEAGUE OF WOMEN VOTERS OF DARE COUNTY

The League of Women Voters of Dare County is a nonpartisan political organization which encourages informed and active participation in government, works to increase the understanding of major public policy issues, and influences public policy through education and advocacy. The local League is affiliated with LWV-NC at the state level and LWV-US at the national level.

In Dare County, the League sponsors candidate forums prior to local elections for town, county, and state officials and publishes a voters' guide about candidates, their biographical information, and platforms. Monthly informational meetings on topics of local interest are held for the general public. An annual project is the printing and distribution of the Dare County Citizens Guide which contains information about government and county services.

New members are welcome at any time. Membership is open to women and men, 18 years and older. Annual dues are \$50 for an individual member and \$75 for a household membership.
